Pascale Vonmont is the CEO and Director of Gebert Rüf Stiftung – Switzerland's largest private science and innovation foundation. With an annual budget of up to CHF 15 million, it fosters breakthrough technologies and cultivates an entrepreneurial mindset by building initiatives like the Kick Program, which accompanies Switzerland's best entrepreneurial talents along the entire value chain.

#### **Life Sciences**

Holding a PhD in Biopolymers from ETH Zurich, Vonmont has led the foundation's life science research programs, addressing critical gaps in research and funding and fostering high-impact solutions:

- Rare Diseases: 31 projects, total budget of CHF 12.3 Mio.
   50% achieved a diagnostic or therapeutic success.
- Microbials: Exploiting the potential and widespread use of microbial resources in health and technology. 29 projects supported, total budget of CHF 10 Mio. Resulted in the successful promotion of young talents, product prototypes to successful founding and financing of companies.

#### **Expertise and Engagement**



#### Creating a Sustainable Value Chain

The programs under "Kick Foundation" and the "Kickfund" are a unique combination of funding and investment. The "Kick Program" offers Switzerland's best talents a broad-based training and funding program for business, technology and innovation. The lean, legally independent Kickfund is directly linked to the funding program. The fund invests systematically in Venture Kick finalists and uses part of the returns to regenerate the pipeline, creating a funding cycle with sustainable added value.
